

**INDIAN TRAILS CONFERENCE  
BASKETBALL RULES**

**GAME SCHEDULING:**

1. All varsity games shall begin at 7:30 pm unless both schools mutually agree otherwise.
2. The JV game shall begin at 6:00 p.m. with the varsity game scheduled to start 20 minutes after the conclusion of the JV game.
3. If the contest(s) are a girls/boys back-to-back, then the first game shall start at 6:00 pm, with the following game at 7:30 pm unless mutually agreed upon by both schools ADs.
4. The host school is responsible for contracting all officials unless arrangements are made with the Executive Secretary to hire varsity officials.
5. Officials may work JV/Varsity or Girls/Boys games on the same evening; however, consideration should be given to having two sets of officials.
6. All Conference games must be officiated by two officials licensed by a State Association.
7. It is recommended that staff members from either school not officiate varsity level games.

**GENERAL GAME RULES:**

1. All games are governed by National Federation High School rules and State adaptations where the host school is located.
2. JV games game length shall be agreed upon by the Athletic Directors from each school.
3. Players shall wear light-colored jerseys for home games and dark-colored Jerseys for road games.
4. A player may participate in both the varsity and "JV" games, but not more than a total of three halves in one day (WIAA Schools).
5. Eighth graders may not compete WIAA schools.

6. A player or coach ejected from the “JV” game may not play or coach in the varsity game during that same day.

**AWARDS – ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS:**

1. A team trophy will be awarded to the Conference Divisional Champion(s).
2. With six or more teams, a first and second All-Conference team made up of six players each shall be selected by the coaches in each division.
3. Coaches shall nominate players from their own team for consideration for both first and second teams, but they cannot vote for their own players.
4. First team “All-Conference” members will receive a medal and a certificate. Second team “All-Conference” members will receive a certificate.
5. Any player nominated, but not selected for either team will be awarded an “Honorable Mention” certificate if they received at least one vote in the balloting for either team.
